

# CLUB RULES

***These Rules must be read in conjunction with all notices published or posted from time to time. All Rules are additional to the matters contained in the Club's Constitution.***

1. A system of booked tee times will be operated. All members have an obligation to honour the bookings that they have made or if not required, take the appropriate steps to cancel the booking – preferably at least 24 hours in advance.
2. Players are not permitted to use the course as a practice ground.
3. Members are not permitted to retrieve golf balls from the fields adjoining the course. Members retrieving balls from the Range do so at their own risk.
4. Range balls cannot be used on the golf course.
5. Trolleys/buggies may be prohibited during winter months, at the discretion of the proprietor.
6. No member can represent the Club in matches, other than friendlies without holding an 'Competition' handicap.
7. Trophy competitions - Entry to these competitions will be restricted to players with a COMPETITION handicap at the closing date of the individual competition entries.
8. Competition Handicaps  
All members of affiliated Clubs with CONGU handicaps are required to submit at least 3 qualifying scores per calendar year to retain a Competition handicap (marked with a 'C'). To have a Competition handicap a member must have returned 3 qualifying scores during the previous year.  
New members can bring their playing record from their previous club as a validation of these criteria.
9. When representing the Club at away matches it is often the agreement that courtesy of the course is offered by the home club. In order for Bromsgrove Golf Club to be able to reciprocate and pay the Centre for the tee times required for the return fixture, a levy is charged to each and every team player (including 'All Inclusive' yearly green fee members) when playing in matches both home and away. This levy is payable in addition to any charge for food (the payment of which is the responsibility of the individual member) which may be made by the Home Club (details of the current levy are displayed in the Changing Rooms).
10. Competition Rules & Regulations - see page 6, 7 & 8.
11. It is the responsibility of all members to read and comply with (in letter and in spirit) Club Rules and notices displayed on the Notice Boards in and around the Clubhouse, and on the Tees before commencing play, and to acquaint themselves with Local Rules and Winter Rules. Notices may only be posted on the boards, by those authorised by the Proprietor and/or Club Officials
