Teams of four (can be mixed). Enter as a team

Handicaps: Max Handicap Men - 30, Ladies - 38. Higher Handicaps can enter and play off maximum.

**HANDICAP ALLOWANCE: 25%, 20%, 15% & 10% FROM
LOWEST TO HIGHEST HANDICAP**

**Open to all members with a WHS handicap Index, who must have competed in and submitted 3 qualifying competition cards in proceeding 12 months
(For Silver & Bronze Members - appropriate weekend green fee applies)**

2022 Spring Scramble Prizes are to be determined by the number of entries.

Spring Scramble

Rules of Golf

The competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf and such Local Rules, Conditions of Competition and Regulations as shall be approved by the Competition and Handicap Committee.

Competition format:

This is a team scramble.

For Silver & Bronze Members (appropriate weekend green fee applies)

Handicap allowance:

Handicaps: Max Handicap Men - 30, Ladies - 38. Higher handicaps can enter and play off maximum. Each team receives an allowance based on the World Handicap System, being the 25%, 20%, 15% and 10% system for four-balls, and the 30%, 20% and 10% for three-balls.

Additional competition rules and conditions:

Eligibility:

Open to all members with a WHS handicap Index, who must have competed in and submitted 3 qualifying competition cards in proceeding 12 months

(For Silver & Bronze Members - appropriate weekend green fee applies)

1. All players tee off, the preferred shot is selected and marked then all players hit again from that same spot. The ball to be placed within 6 inches (no nearer to the hole) of the marked spot if the ball is on the fairway or dropped if the ball is not in the fairway.
1. The best second shot is selected, and all players hit from that same spot, and so on until the ball is holed, producing one team score. On the green the ball to be placed within one putter head length of the marker.
2. If the ball you choose to play is in a hazard (sand, water, etc.), you are not allowed to drop the ball outside of the hazard.
3. Each team must use at least **three** of each team members tee shots
4. The winning pair to be presented with the Spring Scramble Trophy on Presentation Evening plus a voucher.
5. Remaining prizes to be determined by the number of entries.

Competition tees:

White Tees - Gentlemen, Red Tee - Ladies

Pace of play:

1. Under Rule 6.7, the Committee has determined that a maximum Pace of Play target time should be in force for this competition of 4 hours 10 minutes.
2. Under Rule 6.7, the Committee has determined that the Competition Co-ordinators may issue warnings where appropriate with regard to pace of play and if warnings are not heeded, a penalty shot may be applied to each member of the offending group.
