Directors Update

A meeting that was scheduled for late April with our Promotion Company (Blenheim Strategic Partnership) has now been put back to mid-June (date tbc) so nothing to update you on at the moment

Seating in the bar

Two sections of banquette fixed seating that had disapprovingly worn through (right hand side of bar) and required attention have now been repaired by the upholsterer who originally did the work at the time of the refurb. We are delighted to confirm that this work has now been completed satisfactorily and looks pristine once again.

In keeping with our ongoing commitment to maintaining the golf course, as agreed with the commitment with Adam (Head Greenkeeper) when he joined us last year, we are pleased to announce the purchase of a new Tru-turf greens iron and roller. This serious investment demonstrates our dedication to providing the best possible playing conditions for our members and guests.

While our land has been earmarked for potential future development, current indications suggest that this is unlikely to take place for several years.

Therefore, we are confident in continuing to invest in essential machinery, ensuring that the course remains in top condition for enjoyable play throughout the coming seasons.

This Tru-turf RB70, the largest model in its range, features wide triple head smoothing rollers for maximised efficiency. Notably, it is equipped with an integrated trailer system, allowing quick and easy transportation between greens, saving valuable time.

Using this roller will be especially beneficial in maintaining a true and consistent putting surface, particularly when conditions are not suitable for greens mowing.

Maintenance Report

Who would have thought, that after the record amount of rainfall we experienced over the months of January and February that we are looking at the forecast in need of the wet stuff. With no significant rainfall since the first week of March and with overnight temperatures still dropping into low single figures or even below, growth across the course has been minimal which has also meant surfaces are yet to really get going.

To add to this, we have also been experiencing numerous issues with the irrigation system. Thankfully the major issues have all now been resolved, and the system is currently working but there are still numerous surfaces which have system faults which need addressing. This

is why we are also in the process of Auditing our system to make sure all the sprinkler heads are working to their full potential. This process involves checking the arcs, nozzles and making sure they are level. We are upgrading older heads to newer ones where necessary. All our irrigation water is drawn from the 16th lake and as you can imagine the quality of the water is not the best. That is why we have installed a water improvement product which is drip fed into the system whilst it is running. This product converts our lake water which is currently 'not fit for purpose' and makes it 'fit for purpose' and means we are getting the most out of any water we apply. The fountains in the lake also assist in improving water quality.

Unfortunately, we have also been short staffed with one member of staff being let go and another off with sickness. This has meant that we have been limited to what works we have been able to do on the course. Thankfully we have appointed a new assistant greenkeeper who is set to start with us in the coming weeks which will help us massively.

Since the last update

- Greens have been overseeded and followed up with a light sand dressing.
- we are now back on grass tee's where we also have brand new tee markers.
- Brand new hole cups, ThinPins and flags have been put out on the course.
- New cups and flags have been put on the putting and chipping green
- The fountains have been reinstalled back into the 16th lake.

Plans going forward

- Rearrange divot evening when conditions allow
- Selected areas will be treated for weeds but only when turf is healthy enough for recovery
- Some greens are to be extended back to where they originally would have been.
- Pathway works
- Monthly aeration works will continue. This work is vital especially now as we are getting over 200 rounds a golf a day and this number will only rise as we get further into the season.

- Continue to address irrigation issues

Could we also take this opportunity to remind golfers to help your greenkeeping team by adhering to basic golf course etiquette as we have seen a massive rise over the last month in unrepaired pitch marks, unreplaced divots, unraked bunkers and even divots taken out of the greens.
